- 1. Insert the Hand Pump into a jug of distilled water. (fig. 1)
- 2. Prime the bulb by squeezing until filled with water.
- 3. Once the bulb is primed, remove the dust cover from the battery watering system and mate the couplers. (fig. 2)
- 4. Squeeze the bulb with firm pressure to pump water into the battery cells. When the balls stop spinning inside the flow indicator, all cells are full. (fig.3)
- 5. Immediately disconnect the couplers and replace the dust cover.
